Get Prior Year Tax Return Data from the IRS

You will need your 2020 prior year Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) to be able to e-file this year's return. If you do not have a copy of your prior year return, you can access a transcript for those returns from the IRS website. Your AGI will be in that transcript.

If you had <u>earned income</u> in 2019, regardless if you have such income in 2021, and with no upper age limit, *you may qualify for the Earned Income Credit (EIC)*. If you do not have a copy of your 2019 return, you can access a transcript for that return from the IRS website.

We recommend that you request the transcripts online because mail-in requests are still running late due to COVID-19. You will need to enter a separate application for each year requested.
